IS THIS FOR YOU? If you are serious about taking high-resolution aerial photos of Chicago-suitable for framing, murals, books, or magazine publication—in a minimum amount of time, with a maximum amount of success, then this is for you!

LEARN FROM AN EXPERT: John Hill is a renowned aerial and architectural photographer with over 30 years of experience shooting commercial-quality, aerial and architectural photos in the Chicago area. He knows the terrain, cameras, lenses, planes, organizations, regulations, weather, events, and people. With his experience and guidance, you'll develop a stunning portfolio and your best shots will be showcased in an over-sized, exquisitely detailed Photo Trophy Book.

SHOOT AT THE BEST LOCATIONS: Workshops are designed around the weather and special events. Possible venues are numerous and include the Chicago Loop, Lake Michigan shoreline and harbors, Chicago skyline, skyscrapers, sports stadiums & race tracks, museums, light houses, steel mills, etc. Possible special events include fireworks shows, major sporting events, the Mackinac Race, Venetian Night, and NASCAR races.

GO WHEN YOU WANT: You will fly at sunrise, mid-day, sunset, or after dark, depending on your preferences.

FLY THE RIGHT AIRCRAFT AND THE BEST PILOTS: That means Cessna 172, 182, & 210 airplanes with operable windows for the clearest photos and/or A-Star 350/355 helicopters with sliding/removable doors. The pilots are FAA certified commercial pilots, who are usually also flight instructors.

USE THE BEST CAMERAS: Canon 10S3 and 5D2 digital cameras. Hasselblad H3D-2 or Phase One 65+ Medium Format digital camera with appropriate lenses.
